U S S B O G U E


The United States Ship Bogue, an auxiliary Aircraft Carrier, was commissioned at the Puget Sound Navy Yard, Bremerton, Washington, on 26 Sept. 1942. During her first year as a unit of the United States Fleet she steamed over 45000 nautical miles and has touched ports on three continents. During her second year as a unit of the United States Fleet she steamed 86000 miles.
